The following is the response to the clarification submitted to my office:

1. Would you be able to accept a quote and issue an order (if selected) for the dell servers without a Guam Business License?

Response: For IFB 16-02 the Judiciary is requiring that a valid business license from your place of business must be submitted with your bid package. Failure to submit shall result in disqualification from the bid.

2. Would you be able to accept a quote and issue an order (if selected) for the dell servers without a Bid Bond?

Response: Bids will be disqualified if not accompanied by a Bid Bond, Letter of Credit, Certified Check or Cashier's Check. If utilizing a bid bond, letter of credit and or certified check then this must be issued by a local surety or banking institution licensed to do business on Guam. If utilizing a cashier's check for a bid guarantee bond then any U.S. banking institution will be acceptable. All bid bonds must be payable to the Judiciary of Guam in the amount of fifteen percent (15%) of the highest total proposed amount.

Please be reminded that this Addendum no. 2 shall be acknowledged in your bid proposal. Failure to acknowledge this Addendum shall result in disqualification from this bid.
