Private Process Server Program Application Requirements

Minimum Qualifications

- ➤ 18 yrs. or older
- Resident of Guam (at least 1 yr. preceding application)
- Must have no felony or misdemeanor convictions involving fraud and dishonesty
- Must submit to fingerprinting and a background investigation, which shall include the right to obtain and review the criminal record of the applicant, if one exists

Fees

- ➤ \$300.00 for Opening a Special Proceedings Case (For Private Process Servers)
- ➤ \$50.00 for Training, Examination and Background Check by the Marshal of the Courts. This includes identification card and fingerprinting as may be required by the Presiding Judge. (For Government and Private Process Servers)

(These fees must be paid annually at the time of renewal)

Required Documents to be Submitted with Application to the Special Process Server Program Coordinator

- ➤ Application: One (1) original and one (1) copy, plus 3 more copies of the Provisional Certification form attached
- ➤ Guam Business License (Required for Private Process Servers)
- ➤ Declaration stating the applicant is and was a legal resident of Guam for at least one year prior to application and has continually
- ➤ Declaration stating that the applicant will well and faithfully serve process in accordance with the law, and otherwise comply with all laws of Guam and regulations of the Judiciary of Guam
- Declaration stating that the applicant has no felony or misdemeanor convictions involving fraud and dishonesty
- > Two color photographs (2" x 2")
- > Petition for Appointment of Special Process Server
- Provisional Certification (The Annual Standard Certification form will be required upon the successful completion of the Training, Examination and Background Check)
