
Pursuant to its authority to “make and promulgate rules governing the administration of the judiciary and the practice and procedure in the courts of the judicial branch of Guam,” 48 U.S.C. § 1424-1(a)(6) and Title 7 GCA § 3107, and Guam Public Laws 27-79 and 27-81 (through Promulgation Order 06-005-01), this Court established the Mediation Pilot Program for Civil Actions in the Superior Court of Guam (“Pilot Program”) and adopted the Interim Rules for the Mediation Pilot Program for Civil Actions (“Interim Rules”). The Pilot Program was later extended and the Interim Rules amended through Promulgation Orders 06-005-02, 06-005-03, and 06-005-04 to afford a full and proper evaluation of the possible permanent viability of the Pilot Program. That evaluation is nearing completion. However, an additional brief extension of the Pilot Program is necessary.

**THEREFORE**, the Pilot Program and the Interim Rules (as amended) shall remain in effect until March 31, 2014, unless otherwise ordered by this Court.
