Pursuant to the authority to “make and promulgate rules governing the administration of the judiciary and the practice and procedure in the courts of the judicial branch of Guam,” 48 U.S.C. § 1424-1(a)(6), the Supreme Court hereby adopts the following amendment to Rule 1.01 of the Guam Rules Governing Admission to the Practice of Law in order to create a new *ex officio* position on the Board of Law Examiners to be filled by the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Guam.

Rule 1.01 shall be amended to read as follows:

Rule 1.01. Membership.

The Board of Law Examiners (the Board”) shall consist of the Chief Justice and Associate Justices of the Supreme Court of Guam as members, and the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Guam and President of the Guam Bar Association as *ex officio* members. The Chief Justice or his designee shall serve as the Chairperson. The Clerk of the Supreme Court shall serve as the *ex officio* secretary-treasurer of the Board.

This amendment shall apply to all actions, cases and proceedings brought after the instant Promulgation Order takes effect and to all actions, cases and proceedings commenced prior to the effective date hereof and still pending, except to the extent that the application of the





2 work injustice, in which event the prior valid Guam Rules Governing Admission to the Practice
3 of Law shall apply.
