Pursuant to this court's authority to, "make and promulgate rules governing the administration of the judiciary and the practice and procedure in the courts of the judicial branch of Guam," 48 U.S.C.A 1424-1(a)(6), the mandate of Title 7 GCA § 4101(e) that this court, "enact rules governing the efficient dispatch of the Superior Court's business, including . . . (3) assignment, management, distribution, processing, scheduling and disposition of cases in the Superior Court," and upon consultation with the trial court judges relative to suggested adjustments to the manner in which cases are assigned to the judges of the Superior Court of Guam to better maximize equity and efficiency in managing the trial court's business, this court recently adopted Administrative Rule 14-001 regarding amendments to the trial court case assignment procedures which were previously articulated in this PRM series, most recently though Promulgation Order No. 10-003-02. Because Administrative Rule 14-001 now includes the entirety of the trial court case assignment procedures, PRM 10-003-02 is hereby **REPEALED**. Further, this PRM series will no longer be used for case assignment procedures,

1 as Administrative Rule 14-001 and any amendments thereto will hereafter address trial court
2 case assignment matters.
