2 graded. The local question may take the form of an essay question, multiple choice
3 questions or true/false questions. Answers to the MPT question will be written in the
4 answer book provided and shall not exceed eight (8) pages of text (one side of the page
5 only). No writing beyond the lines provided on each page of the paper is permitted. Any
6 answer which cumulatively exceeds the eight (8) page limit shall not be considered when
7 the answer is graded.

10 (b) An applicant's overall MEE/MPT score will be a composite of the scores for the six
11 (6) MEE questions, the local question and the one (1) MPT question. The average on the
12 essay portion overall will be achieved by multiplying the MPT score by two (2), adding
13 that to the combined score of the six (6) MEE questions and the local question, and
14 dividing the resulting total by eight (9).
