PROMULGATION ORDER NO.

Pursuant to Title 7 GCA § 9101 this Court is authorized to establish rules regarding governance of the Guam Bar Association. Further, 7 GCA § 9212(b) expressly authorizes this Court to utilize its Section 9101 rule-making powers to revise the fees paid each year by each active member of the Guam Bar Association (“GBA”) to the Territorial Law Library Fund through the GBA pursuant to 7 GCA § 9212(a).


Therefore, this Court, having duly considered the issues relevant to this matter, hereby adopts the following Rule Regarding Revision of Annual Contribution by Active Guam Bar Association Attorneys to the Territorial Law Library Fund revising the fees contemplated by 7 GCA § 9212(a) which shall be effective immediately and shall be applicable to 2007 dues. The Compiler of Laws is authorized to number and place this rule as appropriate in his discretion in the rules applicable to the governance of attorneys.


Rule _____. Regarding Revision of Annual Contribution by Active Guam Bar Association Attorneys to the Territorial Law Library Fund

The annual fee of the Guam Bar Association payable to the Territorial Law Library Fund in accordance with Title 7 GCA § 9212(a) shall be no more than \$50, to be determined by the Board of Governors of the Guam Bar Association, for each active member of the Bar. The annual fee shall be due and payable on the first day of March of each year pursuant to Title 7 GCA 9212(b).
