RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE FOR
THE SUPREME COURT OF GUAM.**

Promulgation Order: 99-001

The Supreme Court of Guam, having considered the matter on February 19, 1999, has adopted the following as Rule 4.1 of the Guam Rules of Appellate Procedure for the Supreme Court of Guam:

RULE 4.1 - - STATEMENT OF JURISDICTION.


Within ten (10) days after filing the notice of appeal, the Appellant shall submit a statement of jurisdiction to the Court. Such statement shall contain the following: (1) the basis for claiming that the judgment or order appealed from is final or otherwise appealable; (2) the statutory basis of the Court's jurisdiction; (3) the date of entry into the docket of the Superior Court of the judgment or order appealed from; and (4) an attached copy of the judgment or order indicating the document's date of entry into the docket of the Superior Court of Guam. The attached copy shall be legible to the degree that the court may verify the judgment's date of entry into the docket.


The above Rule 4.1 shall take effect immediately upon issuance of this order.
