

**BEFORE THE 2005 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM
RESOLUTION NO. JC05-008**

RELATIVE TO RATIFYING THE EARLIER APPROVAL OF CHANGING SEVENTEEN SPECIFIC POSITIONS FROM CLASSIFIED TO UNCLASSIFIED PURSUANT TO APPLICABILITY OF STANDARDS ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL WITH SUCH CHANGE TO OCCUR ONLY WHEN A PARTICULAR POSITION BECOMES VACANT EITHER THROUGH ATTRITION OR ELECTION OF INCUMBENT TO RESIGN AND BECOME RE-EMPLOYED AS AN UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEE IN THE SAME POSITION

WHEREAS, the Judicial Council of Guam has adopted four (4) standards which shall be used to determine the impracticability of including the various positions throughout the Judiciary in the classified service of the government of Guam; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Courts, with the assistance of the Human Resources Division, has thoroughly analyzed the current classified positions throughout the Judiciary with regards to the four standards and has recommended that the seventeen (17) specific positions identified in Exhibit A hereto and incorporated herein by this reference be converted to unclassified status; and

WHEREAS, the Judicial Council upon oral motion in its regularly noticed meeting of September 30, 2005 approved the conversion of these seventeen (17) positions from classified to unclassified status but with such conversion only to occur upon each position becoming vacant through attrition or due to an election by an incumbent employee to resign their classified status to become immediately re-employed as an unclassified employee in the same position;

WHEREAS, it is advisable that the action of the Judicial Council be through a duly adopted written resolution;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Judicial Council's September 30, 2005 adoption of the Administrator of the Court's recommendations regarding converting the seventeen (17) positions identified in Exhibit A hereto from classified to unclassified status in the manner contemplated herein is **HEREBY RATIFIED.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the effective date of the conversion from classified to unclassified of the respective positions shall occur only when the position becomes vacant through attrition or due to an election by the current incumbent employee to resign his or her classified status to become immediately re-employed as an unclassified employee in the same position.


