

**BEFORE THE 2006 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM  
RESOLUTION NO. JC 06-002**

**RELATIVE TO AMENDING JUDICIAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION JC05-007**

**WHEREAS**, upon oral motion during Executive Session of its regularly noticed meeting of September 30, 2005 the Judicial Council approved the adoption of four separate and distinct standards with which the Judiciary would assess and determine the impracticability of including particular positions in the classified service of the government of Guam and if a determination is made that such is impracticable the particular position shall be deemed unclassified; and

**WHEREAS**, at its regularly noticed meeting of November 16, 2005 the Judicial Council adopted Resolution JC05-007 to ratify such action adopting the four standards; and


**WHEREAS**, upon additional research and review of Standard Four within those standards it has become clear that such Standard Four must be amended in order to remain consistent with the requirement that employees of the government of Guam be included within the classified service to the extent practicable;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Standard Four which was adopted by the Judicial Council and which adoption was later ratified through Resolution JC05-007 shall be amended to read as follows:

STANDARD 4

**PROFESSIONAL TECHNICAL SERVICES POSITIONS AS DEFINED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AS THEY RELATE TO COURT POSITIONS AND OPERATIONS AND AS ARTICULATED BY THE HUMAN RESOURCES ADMINISTRATOR.**
