

**BEFORE THE 2006 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM  
RESOLUTION NO. JC 06-007**

**RELATIVE TO THE RATIFICATION OF THE COUNCIL'S AMENDMENT TO THE  
JUDICIARY'S PERSONNEL RULES AND REGULATIONS TO ADD THE GUARDING  
OF ERICA'S HOUSE BY THE JUDICIARY'S MARSHALS TO THE LIST OF  
HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS IDENTIFIED THEREIN**

**WHEREAS**, Rule 9.32 of the Personnel Rules and Regulations articulates the Judiciary's Hazardous Pay Policy and identifies specific conditions which are hazardous for Marshals and specific conditions which are hazardous for employees of the Probation Division; and

**WHEREAS**, in the course of their employment Marshals of the Judiciary provide security services at Erica's House;


**WHEREAS**, the Judicial Council found that providing security services were not ordinary, customary or routine tasks of the Marshals; and

**WHEREAS**, at a regularly scheduled meeting of February 15, 2006 the Judicial Council approved an amendment to the Rule 9.32 Hazardous Pay Policy recognizing the hazardous nature of the Erica's House security services duty;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Judicial's Council's decision to amend Rule 9.32 of the Judiciary's Personnel Rules and Regulations to include the guarding of Erica's House by the Judiciary's Marshals Division as hazardous duty, is **HEREBY RATIFIED** and thus a new subsection (l) is hereby added to Rule 9.32.01.01 of the Judiciary's Personnel Rules and Regulations to read as follows:

- (l) A Marshal performs security duty at Erica's House.
