

**BEFORE THE 2007 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM
RESOLUTION NO. JC 07-013**

**RELATIVE TO ELIMINATION OF DUPLICATE ATTORNEY FEE PROVISION IN
THE SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM**

WHEREAS, at the April 2007 meeting of the Judicial Council, the Schedule of Fees most recently promulgated under Promulgation Order No. 03-008 of the Supreme Court of Guam on October 24, 2003, was proposed for review; and

WHEREAS, after review by the Clerk of Court and other court staff, the only proposed changes necessary at the current time is found under "Miscellaneous and Other Fees," under a category entitled the following:

In an action pending in Superior Court, the prevailing party may recover the following costs:

- a. For his own attendance and that of his attorneys down to and including final judgment not more than \$100.00.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Revisions to the Guam Rules of Civil Procedure and the Local Rules of Court recommended to the Judicial Council that this recoverable fee be eliminated from possible recoverable costs, as it is a duplication of an attorney fee, and attorney fees are to be treated separately in the issue of the award of court costs by the trial court;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Judicial Council hereby approves that the Schedule of Fees in effect pursuant to Promulgation Order No. 03-008 be changed to eliminate the above-references provision.
