**Resolution Commending the late ELOISE RIVERA BAZA President of  
the Guam Chamber of Commerce for Her Extraordinary  
Partnership and Friendship with the Guam Judiciary**

**WHEREAS, Eloise Rivera Baza**, was the President of the Guam Chamber of Commerce for over twenty-two (22) years, and during her tenure she strongly supporter programs directed towards helping the youth of our island, and in particular at risk and troubled youth; and,

**WHEREAS**, in September of 2001, Ms. Baza and Judge Elizabeth Barrett-Anderson collaborated on a project entitled the “Youth Life Skills Program” a partnership between the Guam Judiciary Juvenile Drug Court Program, and the Guam Chamber of Commerce as represented by the attached booklet; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Juvenile Drug Court Youth Life Skills program is an innovative program to fight juvenile drug usage on island with the development of a curriculum based vocational training incentive project taught by volunteer members of the Guam Business Community to youth in the drug court program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Juvenile Drug Court Youth Life Skills Program was featured nationally at the 2004 National Association of Drug Court Professionals Annual Drug Court Conference in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and was recognized as a unique partnership in the drug court filed; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Youth Life Skills Program provided basic life skills to youth in the drug court program such as financial management, health, self-esteem, goal and employment orientation, sports incentive, automotive basics, and so much more; and,

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of the overwhelming support from the Guam Chamber of Commerce through Ms. Baza’s personal efforts, the Court named the Juvenile Drug Court, and the Adult Drug Court graduation ceremonies as the “Silver Dollar Graduation” in honor of the Guam Chamber of Commerce’s partnership; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Youth Life Skills Program went on to be nationally recognized as an award winning project by the National Chamber of Commerce; and,

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Baza’s support for the Judiciary is also recognized in her support for the Adult Drug Court program clients and graduations as part of the Chamber of Commerce’s Work Force Development program; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Baza’s service to Guam, it’s people, and the business community will be a lasting legacy of her as a civic leader, a daughter and a sister of the Baza Family, and a Friend of the Court.
