



**BEFORE THE 2008 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM
RESOLUTION NO. JC 08-012**

RELATIVE TO COMMENDING JUSTICE F. PHILIP CARBULLIDO FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE JUDICIARY OF GUAM

WHEREAS, The Honorable F. Philip Carbullido, as the date of his appointment as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Guam on January 23, 2003, until January 15, 2008, served as the Chairman of the Judicial Council pursuant to 7 GCA § 5101.

WHEREAS, under the leadership of Chairperson of the Judicial Council from January 23, 2003 to January 15, 2008, Chief Justice F. Philip Carbullido was responsible for several significant milestones by the Judicial Council, including the following achievements:

- Creation of a Task Force to consolidate the Supreme Court with the Superior Court to create a Unified Guam Judiciary;
- Creation of a committee to formulate criteria for and select an Administrator of Courts for a Unified Judiciary;
- Adoption of updated and revised Judiciary Procurement regulations;
- Supporting Organic Act amendments creating the Judiciary of Guam as a separate and equal branch of the government of Guam;
- Creation of an office of the Alternate Public Defender;
- Updating Judiciary personnel rules and regulations;
- Integration of the Compiler of Laws under the judicial branch of government and appointment of first Judiciary Compiler of Laws;
- Creation of a Judiciary Armory;
- Expansion of parking area for court employees and patrons;
- Creation of a Pilot Program for Mediation for cases in the Superior Court of Guam;
- Expansion of partnership with Erica's House Visitation Center and sharing of Judiciary resources;
- Partnership between the Compiler of Laws and the Guam Law Library, a nonprofit educational corporation existing under 7 GCA § 9201; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable F. Philip Carbullido's contributions to the Judicial Council of Guam are numerous, profound and historic;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Judicial Council recognizes that the efforts of The Honorable F. Philip Carbullido, Chief Justice Emeritus, to the Judicial Council of Guam have contributed greatly toward the improvement of the administration of justice in our jurisdiction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Judicial Council hereby thanks Justice Carbullido for his service to the Judiciary as one of the most influential judicial officers to serve in the Judiciary of Guam in the decades of its existence, whose contributions will be felt by generations of Guam's legal and lay community for years to come.
