

**BEFORE THE 2011 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM**

**RESOLUTION NO. JC 11-012**

**RELATIVE TO APPOINTING MEMBERS OF THE  
COMMITTEE ON JUDICIAL DISCIPLINE**

**WHEREAS**, the Supreme Court of Guam first adopted its Rules for Judicial Disciplinary Enforcement on March 27, 2006, memorialized through its adoption of Promulgation Order 06-002-001 on September 5, 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, the Court then amended its Rules for Judicial Disciplinary Enforcement on April 13, 2007 through its adoption of Promulgation Order 06-002-002; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Rule 2.1(D) & (E) of the Rules for Judicial Disciplinary Enforcement this Council appointed six individuals to the Committee on Judicial Discipline on April 18, 2007 with three appointees receiving two-year terms and three appointees receiving four-year terms pursuant to the rules in order to create staggered terms on the Committee as follows: Judge Richard Benson (four-year term), attorney Rodney Jacob (four-year term), Dr. Marilyn Salas (four-year term), Judge Ramona Manglona (two-year term), attorney John Gorman (two-year term), and Dr. Chris Perez (two-year term); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Rule 2.1(D) & (E) of the Rules for Judicial Disciplinary Enforcement this Council, effective April 18, 2009 this Council re-appointed Judge Ramona Manglona, attorney John Gorman and Dr. Chris Perez to each serve an additional four-year term on the Committee on Judicial Discipline; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial four-year terms of Judge Richard Benson, attorney Rodney Jacob and Dr. Marilyn Salas shall expire on April 18, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, Rule 4.1(E) of the Rules for Judicial Disciplinary Enforcement allows a member of the Committee on Judicial Discipline to serve two full four-year terms on the Committee.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that Judge Richard Benson and Dr. Marilyn Salas are hereby re-appointed to serve four-year terms on the Committee on Judicial Discipline commencing April 18, 2011 pursuant to Rule 2.1 of the Rules for Judicial Disciplinary Enforcement.


