



BEFORE THE 2011 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM
RESOLUTION NO. JC 11-017

RELATIVE TO COMMENDING ANDREW SERGIO QUENGA FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE JUDICIARY OF GUAM

WHEREAS, Andrew Sergio Quenga, a 1982 graduate of JFK High School, having earned a Bachelor of Science in 1987, a Masters in Science in 1993 and a Juris Doctorate in 1996, has contributed eleven and a half of his government service years in exemplary service to the Judiciary of Guam, specifically, from November 12, 1999 to April 30, 2000, he served as Research Attorney for the Supreme Court of Guam, and from May 1, 2000 to August 17, 2004, he served as the Supreme Court of Guam Staff Attorney; and

WHEREAS, in Public Law 27-77, the Guam Legislature re-created the Office of Compiler of Laws as an office within the Judicial Branch to "assure that the laws, administrative rules, court reports and other publications of Guam are timely published and regularly distributed," and on August 18, 2004, Andrew Sergio Quenga was the first-ever Judiciary-based Compiler of Laws, having been appointed to the position by Chief Justice F. Philip Carbullido; and

WHEREAS, in 2005 Andrew Sergio Quenga as the Compiler of Laws and with the assistance of the Office of the Compiler of Laws and Guam Code Advisory Commission completed the first official update of the Guam Code Annotated ("GCA"), replacing the older volumes which had not been updated since 1998; and

WHEREAS, since the publication of the first official update of the GCA, Andrew Sergio Quenga as the Compiler of Laws worked on issuing supplements to the 2005 edition; and

WHEREAS, in 2007 pursuant to Public Law 28-068 Andrew Sergio Quenga assisted the Public Auditor in reviewing all existing government of Guam dormant or inactive accounts to determine whether they are no longer necessary or require consolidation caused by evolving mandates, priority changes, outsourcing, privatization, down-scaling, service or program cessation or expansions within the government of Guam and upon review to provide a written report of the findings and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, in 2007 the findings from the review by Andrew Sergio Quenga and the Public Auditor reported in Public Law 28-150:IV:2 resulted in the transfer of Three Million Seven Hundred Ten Thousand Five Hundred Seven Dollars (\$3,710, 507) from the balances in dormant or inactive funds and accounts to the General Fund for FY 2007 operations, including personnel costs; and

WHEREAS, in 2007, Andrew Sergio Quenga took on the additional responsibility of being the Executive Director of the Guam Law Library, and has served proudly and honorably in that capacity since that date; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2008 under Executive Order 2008-14 Governor Felix P. Camacho created and established the Law Revision Commission on Juvenile Justice to review the Juvenile laws and to recommend revisions to the statutes which improve services to juveniles and families involved in juvenile cases; and

WHEREAS, in 2008 Andrew Sergio Quenga was selected as a member of the Commission and has contributed to the Commission's review of the Juvenile laws; and

WHEREAS, in 2010 Andrew Sergio Quenga as a member of the Self-Represented Litigants Subcommittee assisted in the development of legal forms for Uncontested Divorces and Guardianship cases used in the newly-launched Self-Represented Litigants Kiosks and the Access to Justice interactive software system, which are located in the Judicial Center and the Law Library.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Judicial Council recognizes the efforts of Andrew Sergio Quenga for his many years of loyal service, which have brought honor to the Judiciary of Guam; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Judicial Council hereby thanks Andrew Sergio Quenga for his selfless service to the Judiciary and to the many people of Guam whose lives he touched with his dedicated service.
