

**BEFORE THE 2011 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM
RESOLUTION NO. JC11-029**

**RELATIVE TO RECOMMENDING THE CONTINUATION OF THE DWI COURT
OF THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the recommendation of the Judicial Council in JC Resolution No. 10-027, the Supreme Court of Guam established the DWI COURT of the Superior Court of Guam, for a pilot period of November 15, 2010 to December 31, 2011. On November 10, 2010 the Supreme Court of Guam adopted PRM 10-004 establishing the DWI Court as a separate docket for the purpose of consolidating all drunk driving charges before one judge, and supported by federal funding from the National Highway Traffic & Safety Administration, Office of Highway Safety, Department of Public Works, Grant #AL11-01-07; and

WHEREAS, DWI Court judge, the Honorable Elizabeth A. Barrett-Anderson, reported at the regularly scheduled December 2011 meeting of the Judicial Council on the operational success of the pilot program in 2010-2011. The report was of successful outcomes of the DWI Court project, but revealed that in order to continue the project, logistical issues such as judge assigning and case calculation need to be further examined. Judge Barrett-Anderson requested a limited extension of the Pilot program for purposes of determining logistical issues of the DWI Court continuation;

NOW THEREFORE, the Judicial Council recommends that the Supreme Court of Guam order the continuation of the pilot program for another 60 days from December 31, 2011.
