AND EXTENDING CONDOLENCES TO HIS FAMILY**


- WHEREAS**, Norman S. Flores contributed over 14 years of exemplary service to the Judiciary of Guam; and
- WHEREAS**, Norman S. Flores began his Judiciary service as a **DEPUTY MARSHAL I**, under the Marshals Division, Judiciary of Guam on October 27, 1997; and
- WHEREAS**, Norman S. Flores diligently and professionally fulfilled his public service, duties and responsibilities; and
- WHEREAS**, during his service with the Judiciary of Guam, Norman S. Flores received a Letter of Commendation on June 29, 2004 for the successful apprehension of an escaped prisoner on June 27, 2004. Furthermore, a Certificate of Appreciation issued by Chief Justice F. Philip Carbullido and Associate Justice Frances Tydingco-Gatewood on September 30, 2005 in recognition of Norman's contribution to the success of the Judiciary's Silent Witness Ceremony. And a Letter of Appreciation dated October 31, 2005 issued by Sr. Brigid Perez, RSM Program Director for Alee Shelter to the Judiciary's Family Violence Unit where Norman was assigned for the donation of school supplies for the shelter's children; and


