



**BEFORE THE 2014 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM
RESOLUTION NO. JC14-002**

RELATIVE TO COMMENDING JUSTICE F. PHILIP CARBULLIDO FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE JUDICIARY OF GUAM

WHEREAS, Justice F. Philip Carbullido was appointed as Chief Justice of Guam on January 18, 2011 under Promulgation Order PRM11-001, and served as Chairman of the Judicial Council of Guam pursuant to 7 GCA §5101; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 7 GCA § 3103(i), the Honorable F. Philip Carbullido's third term as Chief Justice expired on Friday, January 21, 2014; and

WHEREAS, as Chief Justice and Chairman of the Judicial Council, the Honorable F. Philip Carbullido will be best remembered as the architect of the Judiciary of Guam Strategic Plan, "Our Way Forward," providing a blueprint for the progress of the Judicial Branch for the next several years, including year-by-year goals and measurable milestones; and

WHEREAS, as Chief Justice and Chairman of the Judicial Council, the Honorable F. Philip Carbullido led the Judiciary in many important projects including the following:


- Establishment of Strategic Focus Area Groups to implement the projects outlined in the Judiciary of Guam Strategic Plan
- Improvement of judicial efficiency in the timely issuance of decisions and closure of cases through the case time standards
- Establishment of the Court Interpreter Registry Program.
- Rewriting of Traffic Court Rules and revision of Traffic Court operations
- Adoption of appellate time standards for the Supreme Court
- Adoption of the Judiciary's Talent Management Program, designed to create a corps of talent from which to draw the Judiciary's future leaders
- Oversight of the installation of the new Case Management System
- Partnership with the Guam Department of Education to increase the number of School Resource Officers in the public schools, and increase their skills and law-enforcement training
- Service as the President of the Pacific Judicial Council (PJC), and sponsorship of several PJC-related Court Interpreter Trainings, the PJC 2012 Information Technology Training, and host of the Pacific Judicial Conference Biennial Training in September 2013
- Building on work of predecessors, continuing efforts to increase public participation in Law Week activities, resulting in the American Bar Association selecting Guam as the recipient of the 2012 National Law Day Award.
- Adoption of the motion practice rule for civil proceedings
- Expansion of the Adult Drug Court
- Expansion of the Sex Offender Registry
- Training in and promotion of mediation services
- Establishment of Mental Health Court
- Initiation of the Veterans' Court
- Right-sizing Judiciary personnel
- Implementation of the Judiciary's energy efficiency project and light fixture upgrade
- Implementation of the law enforcement pay and merit bonus pay


