**RELATIVE TO UPDATING SIGNATURE CARD FOR ACCOUNT HELD BY THE JUDICIARY FOR THE PURPOSE OF UTILIZING A DEBIT/CHECK CARD**

**RESOLUTION NO. JC13-016**

**RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE COURTS AND THE  
CONTROLLER OF THE JUDICIARY TO SECURE A DEBIT/CHECK CARD**

**WHEREAS**, entities that do not possess a credit card, debit card or check card and do business with vendors on the internet are increasingly being challenged when placing orders or making payments, and the Judiciary must adapt to the ways in which other governments are conducting business in order to avail itself to the global market and benefit from savings whenever possible; and

**WHEREAS**, the use of the debit or check cards are a more efficient way of purchasing and making payments to off-island vendors, and therefore the Procurement Administrator has proposed to the Judicial Council an initiative to authorize the Judiciary's procurement office to acquire supplies, services, and materials using a debit/check card.

**WHEREAS**, for the purposes of procurement of products and services for the Judiciary, in accordance with the Administrator of the Court's Procurement Policy for the Debit Cards, as presented to the Judicial Council at the June 27 meeting, the Procurement Administrator has recommended that the Administrator of the Courts and the Controller of the Judiciary be authorized to apply for a debit card from a banking institution on Guam;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Judicial Council hereby authorizes the Administrator of the Courts and the Controller of the Judiciary to secure a debit card from a banking institution on Guam to be utilized in accordance with the Administrator of the Court's Procurement Policy for Debit Cards, as presented to the Judicial Council at this meeting, and as the Administrator in his discretion amend from time to time.
