**RELATIVE TO GRANTING THE 2019 HUSTISIA AWARD TO
THE GUAM CHAMBER OF COMMERCE**

WHEREAS, as a regular part of Law Week, the Judiciary of Guam presents the Hustisia Award, an award recognizing a community member or organization that has made an outstanding contribution to strengthening the rule and role of law throughout our island. Modeled on the American Bar Association's Liberty Bell Award, the Guam Judiciary Hustisia Award is meant to honor community partners who contribute to the betterment of our island and the rule of law; and

WHEREAS, in considering the criteria used in determining worthy recipients, specifically, promotion of a better understanding of the rule of law, encouraging a greater respect for law, generating a sense of civic responsibility, and contributing to good government in the island, it is the distinct honor to give this award to the Guam Chamber of Commerce.

Founded in 1924, the Guam Chamber of Commerce marks its 95th anniversary this year. For the past 15 years, the Guam Chamber of Commerce has been one of the Judiciary's most committed partners in ensuring the success of our Drug Court programs, giving financial and mentoring support to nearly 400 drug court participants in our Adult Drug Court program and more than 100 youth in our Juvenile Drug Court program. The Guam Chamber of Commerce also provides training in life skills, and even job offers to those who successfully complete the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 2019 Hustisia Award be given to the Guam Chamber of Commerce for their service to Guam. Our participants and their families, our court, and our island owe the Chamber great thanks for their work and dedication in helping so many individuals turn their lives around.
